

This facility has physician assistants and advanced practice registered nurses to assist in the delivery of pain management medical care. I understand that the physician assistants and advanced practice registered nurses are not doctors.

A physician assistant is a graduate of a certified training program and is licensed by the stated board. Under the supervision of a physician, a physician assistant can diagnose, treat and monitor common acute and chronic diseases as well as provide health maintenance care. "Supervision" does not require the constant physical presence of a supervising physician, but rather overseeing the activities of and accepting responsibility for the medical services provided.

An advanced practice registered nurse is a registered nurse who has received advanced education and training in the provision of health care. An advanced practice registered nurse can diagnose, treat and monitor common acute and chronic diseases as well as provide health maintenance care. In addition, the advanced practice registered nurse may treat minor lacerations and other minor injuries.
